Overview Following a recent Environment Agency officer intervention at a Royal Mail site, this alert reminds PiCs and their deputies on the importance of storing substances, including new and used engine oils in a safe and compliant manner to avoid risks to health and the environment.

Key Message

- Ensure that oil/grease drums are properly stored in bunded containers or on bunded pallets and kept dry.
- Ensure that you have spill kits available and that your people are trained to use them in the event of a spill.
- Ensure that in the event of a spill the Property and Facilities helpdesk is contacted for specialist support to clean up.
- Ensure that substances such as cleaning materials are kept in locked cabinets/cupboards when not in use.
