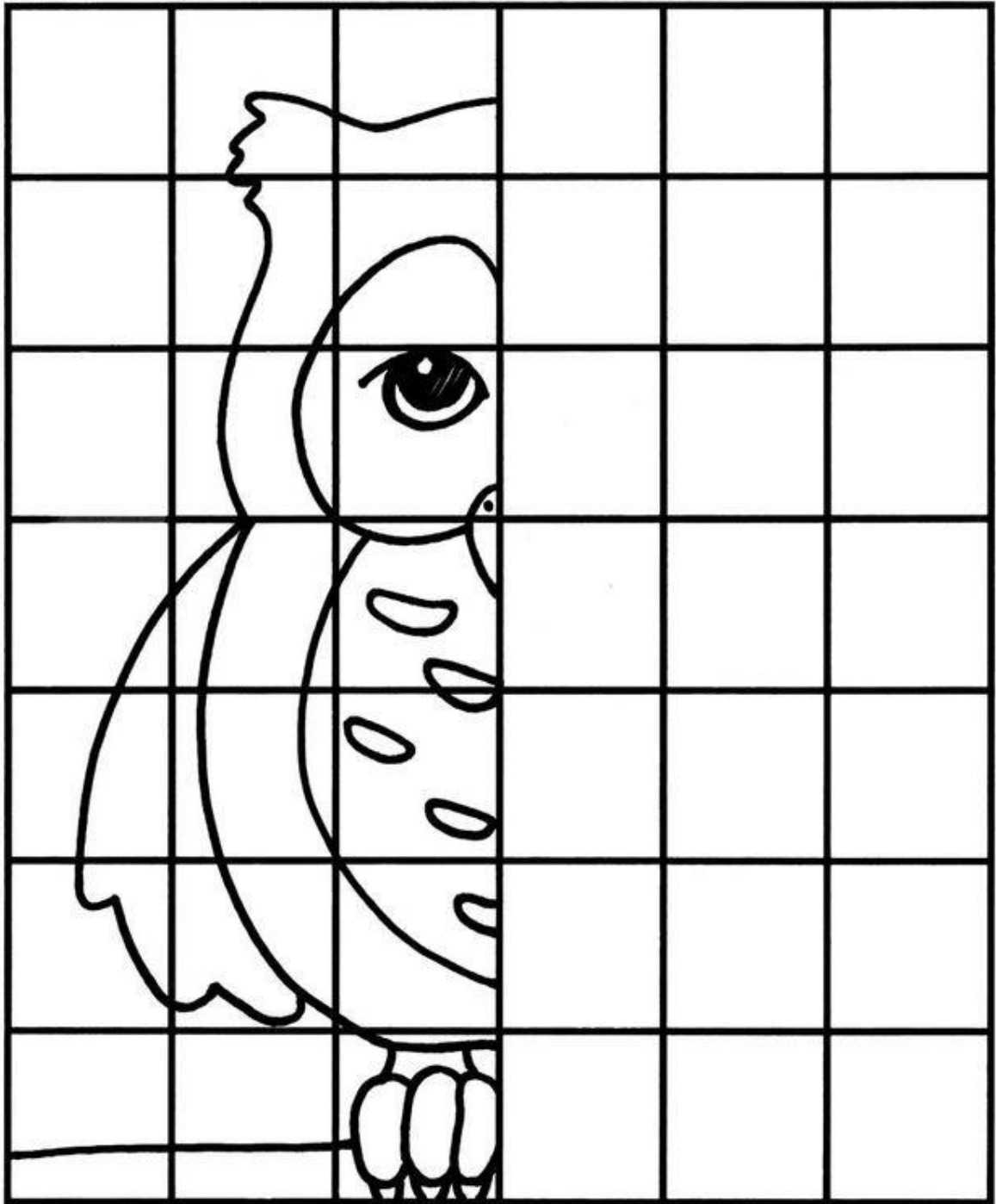

History



On January 8, 1935, in Tupelo, Mississippi, parents Vernon Elvis and Gladys Love gave birth to identical twin boys.

Jesse Garon Presley was the first born unfortunately a still birth followed 35 minutes later by Elvis Aaron Presley. Elvis formed a close relationship with his mother Gladys and attended church which gave him his first musical inspiration.



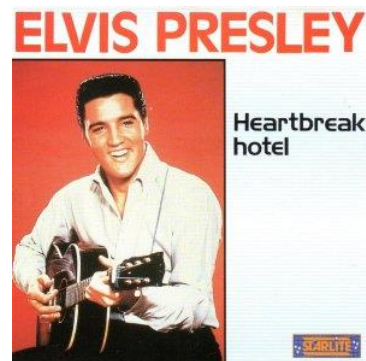
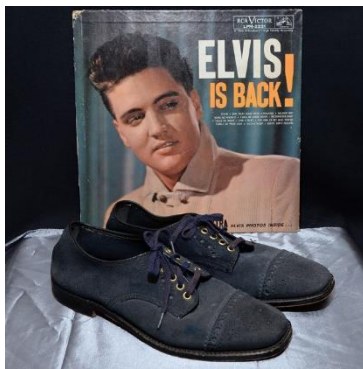
In November 1948, the family moved to Memphis, Tennessee. Elvis enrolled at L. C. Humes High School and would you believe received poor grades for music.

When his music teacher told him that he had no aptitude for singing, he brought in his guitar the next day and sang a recent hit, "Keep Them Cold Icy Fingers Off Me", to prove otherwise.

Presley, had no formal music training and could not read music, he studied and played by ear. He also frequented record stores that provided jukeboxes and listening booths to customers. He knew all of Hank Snow's songs, and he loved records by other country singers such as Jimmie Rodgers, Jimmie Davis, and Bob Wills.

In August 1953, Presley checked into the offices of Sun Records to record "My Happiness" and "That's When Your Heartaches Begin". In January 1954, Presley recorded "I'll Never Stand in Your Way" and "It Wouldn't Be the Same Without You" but had little success and was told he was never going to make it as a singer.

On January 10, 1956, Presley made his first recordings for RCA in Nashville performing Heartbreak Hotel and Blue Suede Shoes and appeared on television.

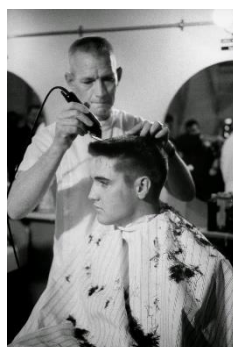


On March 23rd 1956 Presley's first album, was released and became the first rock and roll album to top the Billboard chart, a position it held for 10 weeks.

Elvis and his music went from strength to strength, recording more songs, appearing on numerous television programmes and causing mass hysteria wherever he went from crazed fans.

His first motion picture, *Love Me Tender*, was released on November 21st 1956. Though he was not top-billed, the film's original title—*The Reno Brothers*—was changed to capitalize on his latest number-one record: "Love Me Tender" had hit the top of the charts earlier that month.

On March 24, 1958, Presley was drafted into the U.S. Army as a private at Fort Chaffee, Arkansas. His arrival was a major media event. Hundreds of people descended on Presley as he stepped from the bus. Presley announced that he was looking forward to his military stint, saying that he did not want to be treated any differently from anyone else: "The Army can do anything it wants with me."



While in the army Elvis met 14-year-old Priscilla Beaulieu. They would eventually marry after a seven-and-a-half-year courtship and in 1960 returned from service to the United States. They had a daughter Lisa Marie in 1968.

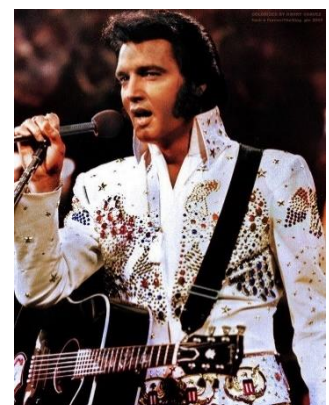
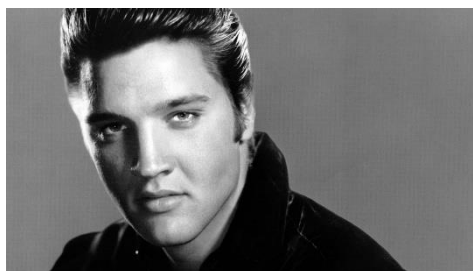


The music and films of Elvis spanned for many years but sadly his marriage had become increasingly distant, barely cohabiting. In 1971, an affair he had with Joyce Bova.

Their divorce was finalized on October 9, 1973, some say this was the catalyst for his declining health. Twice during the year, he overdosed on barbiturates, spending three days in a coma in his hotel suite after the first incident. Towards the end of 1973, he was hospitalized, semi-comatose from the effects of a pethidine addiction.

On the evening of Tuesday, August 16, 1977, Presley was scheduled to fly out of Memphis to begin another tour. That afternoon, he was discovered in an unresponsive state on a bathroom floor and later passed away, the cause of death being a sudden heart attack.

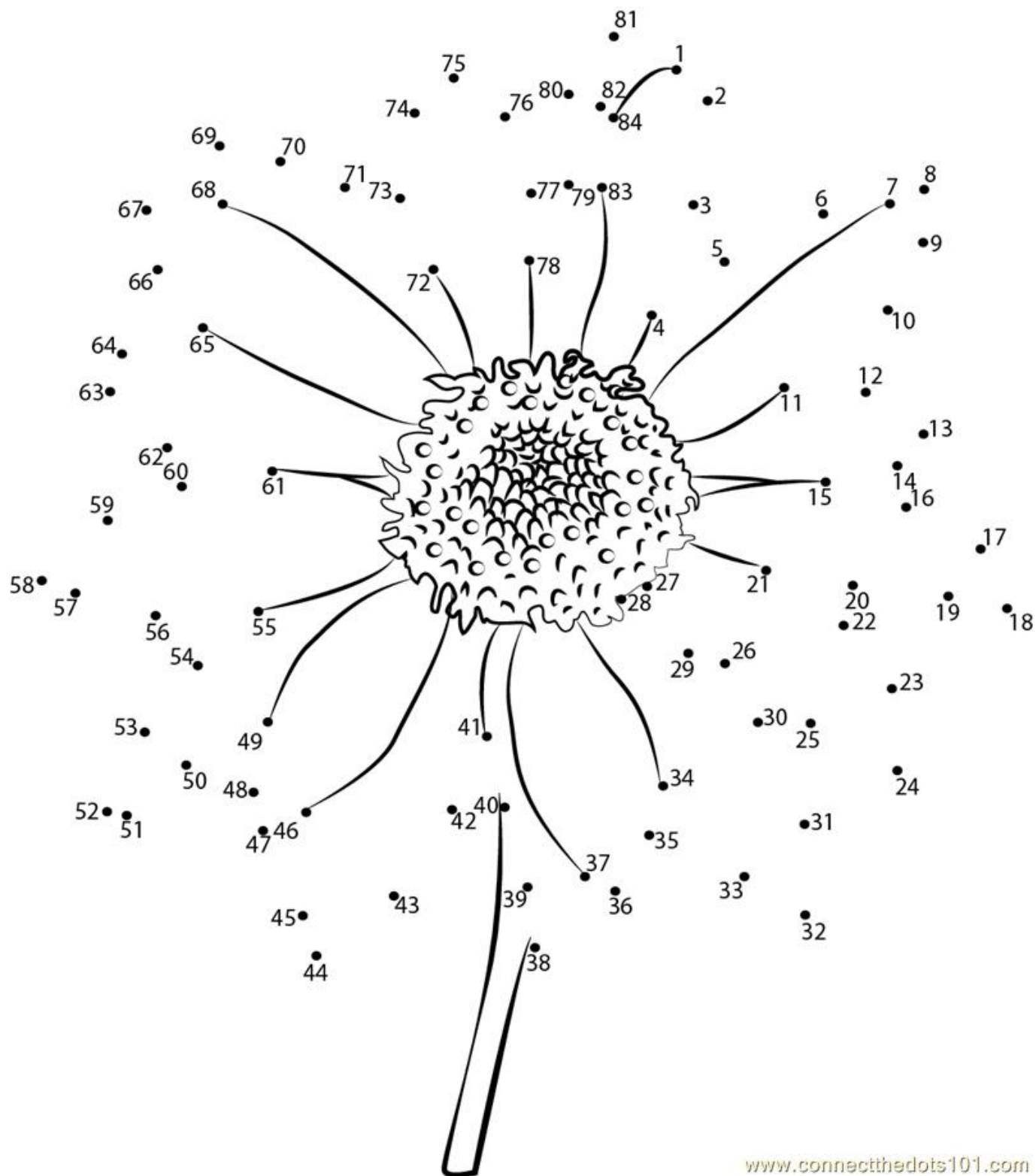
