

History - Reading



This year people across Britain will be commemorating the 75th Anniversary of VE DAY and the ending of World War 2.

On the 8th May n May 8, 1945, fighting in Europe came to a halt as the allied forces finally saw Germany forces surrender and marked the end of Adolf Hitlers reign on war.

The Second World began in 1939 and lasted 6 years troubled years. A state of total war emerged, directly involving more than 100 million people from more than 30 countries.


Alan Turing was an English Mathematician and computer scientist and was highly influential in his field.

During the Second World War, Turing worked for the Government Code and Cypher School at Bletchley Park, just outside Milton Keynes, Britain's codebreaking centre that produced Ultra intelligence.

Here he devised a number of techniques for speeding the breaking of German complex code messaging called Enigma on a machine he developed and built called "The Turing Machine"

Alan Turing played a crucial role in cracking intercepted coded messages with this machine that enabled the Allies to defeat the Nazis in many crucial engagements, including the Battle of the Atlantic, and in so doing helped win the war.

Possibly England's greatest tool in ending the War against the Germans as well as introducing the world to Computers.


