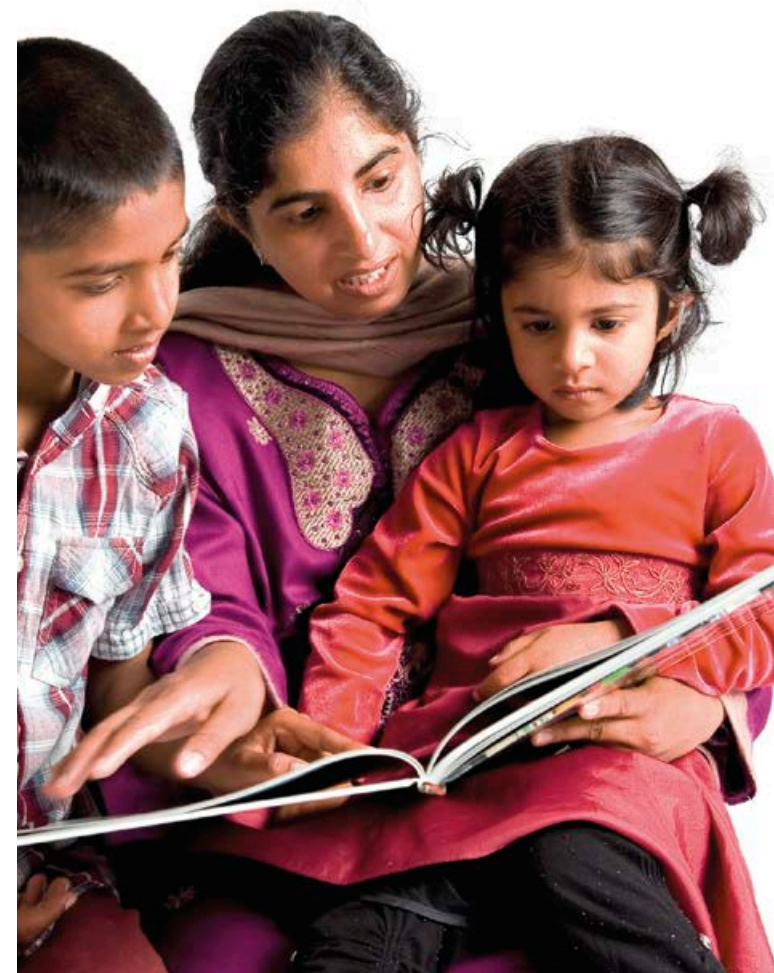

## Bradford Parent and Young People's Partnership Service

The Bradford Parent and Young People's Partnership Service (PYPPS) is a service for all parents/carers of children and young people who have, or may have, special educational needs. Children or young people may also access support from the service.

The service is jointly funded by Barnardo's and the City of Bradford MDC and has strong links with parents groups and the Parent Forum for Bradford and Airedale

In line with the 2014 Special Educational Needs and Disability Code Of Practice 0 to 25 years, the service can:

- Give independent, impartial and confidential information and advice about education, health and social care matters including Personal Budgets.
- Provide a dedicated member of the team to support with arranging, preparing for and/or attending meetings and reviews.
- Provide a link to other statutory or voluntary agencies that may be able to help.
- Support partnership working between parents/carers and professionals.
- Support parents/carers and local statutory and voluntary organisations to monitor and improve opportunities for children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities.
