

Guidelines for Authors of Abstracts Submitted to IFCS 2022

Name of First Author and Name of Second Author

In these guidelines we describe the format instructions for Abstracts, which must be followed seriously. Since all texts have to be compiled together, files that do not comply with this format will not be accepted. The text of these guidelines is written in the prescribed L^AT_EX format and should be used as a specimen.

The length of the abstract including references cannot exceed one page.

Specify 3 to 5 keywords in your abstract using the command `\keywords`.

You may include up to three references. References should be *cited* in the text by number. The **styling** of references is depicted in [1, 2, 3] for, respectively, a Chapter in an edited book, a Book/Monograph and a Journal paper.

Please pay attention to the **capitalization style** for each type of reference.

Always use the standard abbreviation of a journal's name according to the ISSN *List of Title Word Abbreviations*, see <http://www.issn.org/en/node/344>.
