

Multi Band Spectrum Award Final Assignment Plan

Information Notice

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- On 14 December 2022, ComReg published an Information Notice (Document 22/105)¹, which set out the Main Stage² results of the Multi Band Spectrum Award (MBSA2)³. This advised that there are four Winning Bidders⁴:
 - Eir;
 - Imagine;
 - Three; and
 - Vodafone.
- On 19 December 2022, ComReg published an Information Notice setting out the Provisional Assignment Plan along with the Additional Prices for each Winning Bidder (Document 22/112)⁵, and notifying the Winning Bidders of the opportunity to negotiate a reorganisation of the Provisional Assignment Plan under the Negotiation Phase of the MBSA2.
- 3. The Negotiation Phase closed on 11 January 2023 with no changes to the Provisional Assignment Plan.
- 4. The Final Assignment Plan for the Winning Bidders in the MBSA2 is set out in Figure 1 and Table 1 below.
- 5. The Auction stages of the MBSA2 award are now complete.

Next steps

- 6. ComReg is now commencing the remaining stages of the MBSA2 award, being:
 - the Notification and Grant Stage where, among other things, MBSA2 Liberalised Use Licences will be issued to the Winning Bidders; and



 the Transition Phase which, among other things, obliges the existing licensees in the 2.1 GHz band (Eir, Three and Vodafone) to make adjustments to their networks (i.e. carry out Transition Activities) to comply with the outcome of the MBSA2 award.
