

Next Level Skillnet members are given financial support with training costs (fee subvention) for their employees. This can be as much as 40% of the course cost. Members are also entitled to free attendance to workshops & events.

### How do we become a member?

Becoming a member of our network couldn't be easier, there is no membership fee and the only criteria we have are: -

- that the company is **not** a public-sector company
- company must either be paying employee's fees directly or if the employee is paying their fees they should be being reimbursed.
- Self-Employed individuals are eligible for funding

### Are there any forms to complete?

We ask members to complete: -

- a member application form
- and to complete a Training Needs Analysis survey

Employees undertaking training will also be asked to complete a trainee profile form and at the end of their course a feedback form.

### Where does the funding come from?

Next Level Skillnet is co-funded by Skillnet Ireland and member companies. Skillnet Ireland is funded from the National Training Fund through the Department of Education and Skills.

### How does the payment process work?

Next Level Skillnet will invoice the member company directly for the training cost/s due for their employee/s minus the discount. The member company will then make payment to Next Level Skillnet. Once payment has been received the training provider will invoice Next Level Skillnet for the full amount and Next Level Skillnet will pay the training provider directly. Our payment terms are 30 days from the date of the invoice.
